Spring 2010 Centennial Camporee Name Contest
Theme: BSA Centennial
September 1, 2008 until December 31, 2008

Competition Rules:

1. Competition is open to currently registered youth members of the Los Angeles Area Council, BSA only.
2. Submitted name is to be the original idea of the youth member only.
3. Name is to be submitted on one 8 ½ inch by 11 inch sheet of paper.
4. Only one name per sheet of paper is permitted.
5. More than one name may be submitted.
6. **ON THE BACK** of the paper **PRINT** the youth's name, District, unit type, unit number and phone number. For example, "Sam Smith, Rio Hondo, Troop 1000, (562) 555-4567."
7. **MAIL** your entry to: LOS ANGELES AREA COUNCIL; Centennial Camp-O-Ree, Chairman; 2333 Scout Way; Los Angeles, CA 90026. Mail entries ONLY please.
8. The contest will run from September 1, 2008 until December 31, 2008. Entries must be postmarked not later than 12/31/08 and received by 1/5/09.
9. Entries **will not** be returned.

Tips:

This will be a the official name of the LOS ANGELES AREA COUNCIL, BSA Centennial Camporee so remember the Scout Oath and Law when developing your name entry. Copyrighted material (corporate slogans, advertising materials) can't be used, **unless**, along with your entry, you submit written permission from the holder of the copyright to use their slogan, etc. The official name will also be used on the official Camporee patch.

The name may be accompanied by other words if desired, for example
100 YEARS OF SCOUTING – 100 MILLION GOOD TURNS.

Selection and Display: Selection of the winning name(s) will be made at the direction of the Camporee Chairman at the meeting of the Centennial Committee early in 2009. Decision considerations will be: appropriateness to the theme, originality and other factors. The Camporee Committee reserves the right to make modifications to the winning entry. The winning name(s) will be displayed at the April 2010 Centennial Camp-O-Ree.

Reward: The winner of this contest will have BRAGING RIGHTS, and will receive a certificate and recognition at the Centennial Camp-O-Ree Campfire. In addition, the winner may receive a prize such as a gift certificate, sports event tickets, US Savings Bond, campership to a Council camp, etc.
