



NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING

LAAC - 2011 Weekend & Weeklong Courses

NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training) is a focused, high-energy, participatory leadership course for Boy Scouts and Venturers. During the summer of 2011 the Los Angeles Area Council will be offering this national leadership course at two different times and locations. The first offering is a coed course for Venturers and Boy Scouts, and held on two 3-day weekends. The second is a traditional weeklong format for Boy Scouts only.

WHAT:

A primary Scoutmaster and Venturing Advisor's role is to train their youth in leadership skills. **NYLT** is geared to support this process. Some course objectives include:

- Knowledge and application of the learning cycle - **BE, KNOW, DO**.
- Developing team visions, setting and attaining **SMART** goals.
- Providing youth with a "skills toolbox" using the latest concepts and practices employed in today's professional training and best management practices (**BMPs**).
- Effective skills in communication, the teaching **EDGE**, team development, problem solving - **EAR**, conflict resolution and making ethical decisions.

All offered in a fun environment with a program infused with the Scouting Spirit.

Modeling "a month in the life" of an ideal Crew or Troop, each **NYLT** Team will be challenged to present its own "Quest for the Meaning of Leadership." This challenge is designed to have each go through the four (4) stages of team development; and, help the teams internalize the leadership concepts and skills presented along the trail through **NYLT**.

WHO:

Scouts and Venturers interested in becoming better and more effective leaders both in Scouting and in life. By June 1st, 2011, Venturers must have completed the Venturing Crew Leadership Skills course or the Crew Officer Seminar. By June 1st, 2011, each Scout must be First Class or above in rank; be at least 13 years old; and, have completed their Troop-run TLT (Troop Leadership Training).

WHEN:

- Course Option 1 - **Extended Weekends** Coed Course (must attend both weekends):
 - Weekend Session 1 - Friday through Sunday, 17-19 June 2011; and,
 - Weekend Session 2 - Friday through Sunday, 24-26 June 2011.
- Course Option 2 - **Weeklong** all-Scout Course:
 - Monday through Saturday, 8-13 August 2011.
